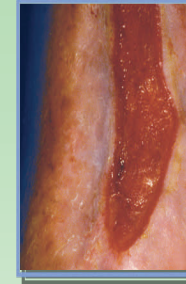

## ULCER PREVENTION TIPS

The following measures may help avoid ulcers in those who may be susceptible:

- ◆ Check the skin daily for dryness, cracks, sores, bruises, reddened areas and blisters
- ◆ Treat skin gently
- ◆ Cleanse skin with a mild, pH-balanced product
- ◆ Remove all cleanser residues from the skin.
- ◆ Dry all skin folds and creases
- ◆ Pay special attention to the area between, under and around toes
- ◆ Moisturize skin. Lubricate dry skin with a heavier barrier type product after moisturizing. *Do not apply lotions or creams between the toes, only to the tops and bottoms of feet*
- ◆ Wear soft clothing
- ◆ Drink adequate amounts of water
- ◆ Maintain proper nutrition
